

## EXAMPLES OF REIMBURSABLE ACTIVITIES

- Discussing health related services such as psychological, speech, counseling, physical therapy, nursing, medications, etc. at an IEP, SST, parent conference or informal meeting.
- Referring students to Medi-Cal providers within the school system or within the community (this could include speech or physical therapists, nurses, psychologists, counselors, doctors, dentists, specialists, health clinics, family planning, substance abuse etc.).
- Referring student/parent to CPS for health abuse or neglect that connects student to Medi-Cal covered health/mental health services.
- Referring student/parent to counseling mental health psychologist, etc. during SARB, probation, IEP, SST, parent conference, suspension/expulsion hearing, etc.
- Preparing and/or presenting outreach information regarding local health services and providers within the school or local community at Back to School Night, Parent Meetings, etc.
- Designing/planning/coordinating responses to emergency health situations.
- Developing an MOU with a local dentist to provide non-mandated dental assessments.
- Developing and maintaining Medi-Cal resource information and directories of services.
- Attending the Healthy Start Advisory Committee when discussing Medi-Cal covered services.
- Participating on an interagency committee to develop strategies for schools to better access Medi-Cal covered services.
- Teacher discussing student's health concerns with school nurse, psychologist, counselor, etc.
- Monitoring and coordinating student health needs in coordination with service provider or case manager (behavior plans, ADD/autism, medication plans, non-mandated vision/hearing concerns, mental health plans, health treatment plans, OT/PT, etc.).
- Arranging for a translator or translating to parents/staff about a student's health needs/concerns or to inform parents regarding a referral for health/mental health services.
- Scheduling or arranging for student's transportation to Medi-Cal covered services only (*not transporting the student*).
- Determining health needs of students by gathering information, reviewing cums, health records, anecdotal notes, interpreting results etc.
