

What is Medi-Cal Outreach?

Providing outreach is either directly referring individuals to health/mental health services, providers, or Medi-Cal/Healthy Families or providing information about where and how to access these health services within the school and/or community.

Informing about and/or referring to Medi-Cal Providers within the school setting:

- School Psychologist
- School Counselor
- School Nurse
- Speech Therapist
- Physical Therapist
- Occupational Therapist

Informing about and/or referring to local Medi-Cal Providers in the community:

- ENT (ear, nose, throat specialist)
- Optometrist, Ophthalmologist (vision)
- Doctor/Clinic (CHDP, physicals, injuries, chronic absences, etc.)
- Public Health Department (immunizations, physicals, screening, etc.)
- Public Mental Health Clinic (counseling, psychological evaluations)
- Hospitals (emergencies)
- Physical/Occupational Therapists
- Speech Therapist

If you are doing a mass distribution of Medi-Cal information, you can only use that topic ONCE PER YEAR. You can use it again for individuals.

Code 4 Narrative Samples:

The narrative must include the specific Medi-Cal service/provider being linked to the student/family.

- During parent conference, I informed parent about Medi-Cal covered speech therapy services provided through the district.
- On Wednesday, I distributed H.E.R.E. Program flyers that included Medi-Cal covered counseling services contact information.
