## Minutes for Tuesday January 19, 2021

### 1.) Call to Order and Introductions

The meeting called to order at 12:43 PM. No quorum present until 1:42pm

### 2.) Public Comment

### 3.) Council Business (Discussion and Possible Action)

#### a.) Council membership updates (discussion)

The Superintendent has reappointed Lisa Matheson. Lindsay Bertolucci has her interview with Rich DuVarney, Superintendent of Tehama County Schools and Jane Lonsberry. Lisa Stephens was invited to apply for the Child Care Provider representative council member opening.

#### b.) Workforce Development Grant discussion (discussion and possible action)

The new Workforce Development Grant is rolling out. Program coordinator/advisor has begun meeting with providers. They will create Professional Growth Advising Plans and discuss Quality Counts. Providers need to have 21 training hours in Trauma Informed Care, Diversity, Inclusion and Dual Language learners. 47 Applicants total today, 27 from State Preschool and 20 from FFN, FCCHEN and NCCDI

#### c.) Covid Response Updates (discussion and possible action)

- I. LPC Coordinator is collaborating with CCRE and First 5 Tehama to receive Covid supplies from CCRE in Shasta County. There are 2 pallets of Covid supplies that need to be delivered/brought to Tehama County. Jane, Heidi and Brian discussed where the supplies can go to be disbursed out to providers.
- II. Still have to abide by Covid protocols if you get vaccinated.

**d.) Management Bulletin 20-21 Regarding Local Planning Councils** (discussion)

CDE-New management bulletin to update LPC's and Resource and Referrals role in Covid-19 response. Guidance to continue current work and to intensify efforts to direct the community to available resources that encourage best practice and strategies to support children and families in the community.
