## Minutes for Tuesday June 16, 2020

### 1. Call to order and Introductions

The meeting was called to order at 12:37 pm. No quorum present. Report outs were made. No actions taken.

### 3. Council Business

#### a. Tehama LCCPC In-Kind

Coordinator will resend In-Kind forms. Please fill out and turn in. In-kind is heavy in the third quarter. The deadline to turn in In-kind is June 30.

#### b. Tehama LCCPC Upcoming meeting dates

There will not be a meeting in July. LCCPC meetings will resume in August. Will discuss next year's meeting dates in August.

#### c. Workforce Development Grant Plan for 2020-2021

LCCPC Coordinator is working on writing the grant application and she received some input last week from local advisory committee. The Tehama LCCPC would be the neutral space for decision making. The plan will be similar to AB212 with an expansion of the program to include more variety of provider types across ECE settings. This grant would bring in more funding to our local ECE Workforce to go stipends, books and supplies. Family, friend, & neighbor child care provider supports will also be included in the new grant.

#### d. Tehama LCCPC purchasing and fiscal updates

For 2019-2020 supplies purchased include provider resource books, social emotional kit supplies for providers, and supplies for Provider Recognition event.

The ELO Grant funds for Tehama went through TCDE Early Childhood Programs. Janet purchased NAEYC subscriptions, and multilingual and

multicultural literacy materials for participating Quality Counts sites across Tehama County.

For the 20-21 fiscal year the LCCPC Coordinator will have calendar reduced to 142 days for 20-21 year. If LCCPC is awarded the Workforce Development Grant may be able to add days to Coordinator for Workforce development and professional growth advising.

**e. Tehama Covid-19 Child Care Response updates**

Report out from the sub-committee. The committee will plan for a week to get survey out, a week to gather, looking at the second week of July to get supplies to providers. Provider supply distribution will include materials and supplies from Child Care Referral and Education, First 5 Tehama, and emergency response kits purchased by the ELO grant for qualifying FFN and FCC sites. Other materials to potentially go out in the Fall to kick off academic year. Volunteers to deliver to sites welcomed.

**f. Quality Counts Updates**

All child care programs encouraged to apply online at Quality Counts North State website. Licensed and license exempt providers welcome to apply.

**a. Center Based**

State Preschool- Getting new flooring in classrooms June 19, would like to open July 1. NCCDI opened in June for full day and will hold a 4 week Kinder camp in July

**b. Family Child Care Programs**

FCCHEN-Providers have trickling back in on spots. Taking precautions on sign ins & outs. 9 families received child care through June

**c. Home Visiting Programs, State**

Cal Works Home Visiting-contracted w/ public health, phone meetings and face time.

First Five Tehama- Has been working on a Grant for Home Visitor Coordination Grant, but has changed to support to Collaborations and is non-competitive.
