## Minutes for Tuesday September 15, 2020

### 1.) Call to Order and Introductions

The meeting was called to order at 12:36 pm. No quorum present.  
Report outs were made. No actions taken.

### 2.) Announcements

- a. Role of LCCPC Council Overview tabling until future meeting after open positions are filled for new LCCPC members to be present. Will add to November agenda.
- b. **SERRF** is up and running at the Shasta College Annex in Red Bluff. For now all the kids they serve in Tehama County are there. They have some full day and part day students attending. Teachers and students are excited to be there. SERRF has the teachers and students in cohorts, keeping everything covid-19 compliant. Teachers brought in classroom decorations to help the kids feel at ease. SERRF has reported that working with Shasta College has been a dream, they couldn't have asked for a better place!
- c. **FCCHEN** is full. School age childcare has impacted enrollment.
- d. **Preschool** is face to face. Now they are also offering distance learning. All sites are full but Jackson Heights and Columbia.
- e. **Corning Promise Neighborhood** is gearing up for another year. They have renamed book parties to community events. They will be doing drive through events in Corning and Rancho Tehama soon.
- f. **NCCDI** some centers opened in August and the rest opened in September. They are doing face to face, distance learning and the Home Visitors are doing virtual visits. Enrollment is up, the largest class has 16 attending, and is divided in cohorts.
- g. **Lisa** (child care provider) has 8 kiddos, doing extra cleaning.
- h. **Workforce Grant** This is the first year collaborating with CPIN and Hub to create a Professional development list for providers and preschool teaching staff. The focus

areas for this grant are Inclusion, Trauma Informed practices, and Dual Language learners.

i. **Quality Counts**

New Pathway Plan for upcoming grant cycle. Previous cycle ended June 2020. Participating programs choose their own participation path.

New MOU forms now finalized so Coordinators can begin scheduling kick-offs later this month (September)

j. **Membership recruitment updates**

Lindsey is applying. There are openings for Child Care Provider and Community Member (non child care provider) positions.

Conducted Individual outreach to 3 family child care providers, 1 family home visitor, 2 SERRF staff invited to the September LPC meeting.

k. **In-Kind** is due for July, August & September. Please include any subcommittee meetings.

l. **LCCPC Self-Evaluation Report**

To complete self-evaluation needs to have input from the council an open to parent and provider public input. Will be on the next LPC agenda for discussion.

m. **Nomination of Officers**

n. **CCRE (R&R)** No new updates. No more supplies coming in. Lindsey will check on thermometers.

o. **CPIN** No new changes. There are about 5 trainings scheduled for 1 or 2 months out and a 2 part zoom training also scheduled.

p. **First 5 Tehama** Corning Promise Neighborhood funded a Trauma Informed Practice with Jessica Spangler. First 5 Tehama and Corning Promise Neighborhood are working on a Leadership Academy for parents. First 5 Tehama will be moving their office to Cedar x Washington soon. Heidi reported that the Job Center has reached out to them for Family Child Care Licensing.
