

School Readiness¹ Summary of Accomplishments 2014/2015

Home Visits

426 children (214 Corning, 30 Gerber, 40 Los Molinos, 140 Red Bluff) received home visits this year for a total of 1669 home visits and 233 case management services. 92 PATH 1 families have received assistance or resources from School Readiness.

<u>Classes</u>

160 classes for families and children were provided by School Readiness this year including 127 playgroups held in Los Molinos, Corning, Red Bluff, and Cottonwood. 2 family winter dinner events where 26 families attended (14 Corning, 12 Red Bluff). 2 READY! for Kindergarten workshops were provided and 28 Nurturing Parenting Classes in collaboration with Tehama County Mental Health (14 Corning, 14 Los Molinos). 87 children from 9 different schools attended Kinder Camp this summer and more than 580 children's books were distributed to children this year from School Readiness Programs.

Preschooler find

166 preschool age children were found this year that had not had previous preschool experience. School Readiness made 157 referrals to Early Learning programs for children and families.

Screenings

174 children received developmental screenings or assessments from School Readiness –27 children were referred for further evaluation. 298 kindergarten screenings were completed.

School/ Community Outreach

We had community resource tables at many events such as: School Meet n Greets and Ice Cream Socials, State Preschool Parent nights, School Back to School Nights, and Open Houses, Walmart Baby Days, High School Career Day, Give Kids A Smile Day, Children's Fair, Cinco De Mayo Celebration, Parent Choice Conference, Health Service Agency, Social Service, Alternatives to Violence, and our Coordinator was on television on Moms Every Day!

<u>Transition Planning/System of Care</u> School Readiness¹ continues to refine the transition plan for Gerber and Los Molinos Corning and Red Bluff schools and facilitate transition to kindergarten. We are strengthening and improving the county-wide system of care for young children and their families.
