

SERRF Registration 2020-2021 Information:

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Due to the current COVID-19 health-related circumstances, SERRF registration will be distinctly different this year. For the first time, we are implementing an on-line registration process. We are excited about this new, convenient, and safe approach! The form is fairly simple to complete, detailed instructions are linked here. You will need to have a valid e-mail address. Please have your child's medical information, including insurance at hand.

We will be staggering the registration dates for specific SERRF sites. There will be an on-site registration option (see schedule below) available for families that DO NOT have access to internet or an electronic device – smart phone or computer. PLEASE NOTE: A limited number of devices will be available. In addition, bi-lingual support will be provided to offer assistance. All CDC recommended protocols for safety/sanitation will be observed at these locations.

Please adhere to ALL of these guidelines, as the system will NOT allow you to register prior to your scheduled day or time.
