

FAQS - Frequently Asked Questions - Summer 2022

Do I need to fill out a separate registration form for each child?

- Yes

All fields must be filled in, otherwise enter N/A

What if I did not register my child on the date registration opens.

- You can register anytime starting April 11th.
- April 11th – May 13th on- line registration will be available.
- Registrations received after May 13th will be considered "waitlist" status until enrollment numbers are determined.
- Starting May 16th paper registrations will be available.
- Students are accepted on a first come, first serve basis.
- If you do not receive an email with your registration confirmation within 24 hours your form was not properly submitted, you will need to re-submit the on-line registration.

Will paper registration forms be available?

- Yes - Paper forms will be available.
- Paper forms will be available at the Tehama County Department of Education – 530-528-7381, and at all school sites.

Where can I mail signed registration forms?

Where can I drop off signed registration forms?

- At any school site.

What if my student does not attend one of the schools listed?

- Anyone in grades incoming K through incoming 8th grade can register and attend.

What verification is needed for foster students?

- Document from foster agency, stating student is a foster child in your home, needs to be attached to a completed Fee Adjustment Request Form, available from the SERRF Office.

When will I know if my child has been accepted into the SERRF program?

- You will be notified by email by May 27th

What if I have more than two emergency contact numbers?

- List two now and at the start of school please contact the site facilitator and add any additional names or numbers that might be needed.

Student Summer Registration Fees:

- Antelope Summer Program – Antelope District Students, NO Charge
 - Verification of enrollment in Antelope, Berrendos or Plum Valley will be confirmed with the district
- Red Bluff Elementary Summer Program - TBD
- Los Molinos Summer Program – No Charge
- Rancho Tehama Summer Program – No Charge
 - Funded US Department of Education Promise Neighborhood Grant Program administered by the Paskenta Band of Nomlaki Indians
- Woodson Summer Program – No Charge

What if I am unable to afford the summer registration fee?

- There is a box on the summer registration to check if there is a financial hardship, and you want to request a district sponsored scholarship. There is a limited number of scholarships available.

What if I have a change to my address or phone number after I submit the registration?

- Contact the SERRF office at 528-7381 so your information can be updated.

What if I do not have insurance information?

- Put in N/A and submit information to the SERRF office as soon as you have the information.

Why do I need to submit a new medical authorization form if my student already has one on file.

- The SERRF summer program does not have access to student files from sites or previous school year.
- If your student uses an inhaler, epi-pen, or has other medical needs a current Medical Authorization Form must be submitted before your student may attend the program.
- Call the SERRF office at 530-528-7381 to obtain the form, or use the link on the on-line registration.
- Parent is responsible to provide the inhaler or epi-pen at the start of summer program.
- Be sure student name is on each item.

Why do you want my email address?

- Your email will NOT be shared with any other agencies. The email will only be used to notify you of upcoming important SERRF related information concerning the Summer SERRF Program.

Is there transportation for Summer SERRF Programs?

- Antelope Summer Program – no transportation
- Red Bluff Elementary Summer Program – limited transportation
- Los Molinos Summer Program – transportation for Gerber & Vina students only
- Rancho Tehama Summer Program – limited transportation
- Woodson Summer Program – limited transportation
- The bus schedule will be posted on our website by Tuesday, May 31st
- It is the parent's responsibility to transport should the bus schedule not work for your student.
